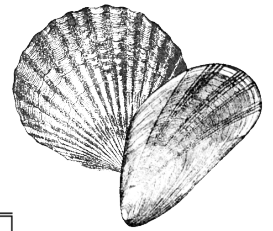

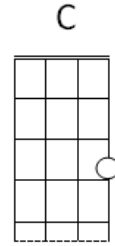

Intro. (tune of last line of chorus): (G7) – C-Em, Em-Am, Am-G7, C

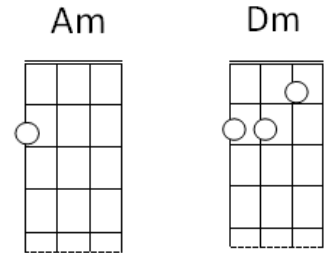
V.1- * C Am Dm G7

 Crying cockles and mussels a-live, a-live, Oh!



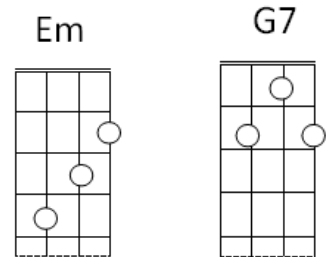
*Starting note: ^ (G)
